Sustaining by entertaining!

The Otjiwarongo Crocodile Farm was founded in 1985 with a breeding herd of 60 adult Nile Crocodiles. To date it is the only Crocodile farm in Namibia and it serves as an important conservational tourist attraction: hence sustaining by entertaining! Apart from safe-guarding the Namibian Crocodile population, it also recycles a lot of waste from the meat, fish and poultry industry as Crocodile feed.

Crocodile Farming is one of the pillars of aquaculture and it promises a livelihood for many small entrepreneurs. Apart from the international value of high quality skins, crocodile meat is a delicacy. Due to the low methane gas emissions of crocodilians, it can truly be classified as a green farming project. Crocodile Meat is rated as Low Carbon Food since it even has a lower Carbon Footprint than poultry. Whereas 50g of Beef is responsible for the emission of about 35kg of CO₂e, 50g of Crocodile Meat only releases about 4kg of CO₂e during the food production process.


Crocodile meat is therefore Clean and Green.

The Otjiwarongo Crocodile Farm also takes pride in applying animal-friendly and sustainable husbandry practises.



Although modern crocs have been around for some 80 million years, they are only small replicas of the crocodilian relatives that once ruled our planet. Over centuries many lines of crocs have become extinct.

Fortunately illegal hunting for crocodile skins has been replaced by legally managed farming and harvesting, allowing many crocodilian species to rebound. During the 1980s about 20 species were listed as endangered whereas now only seven species are still seen as endangered due to the loss of most of their habitat.
